The overall objective of the project is to reduce poverty by improving dairy farm incomes, household nutrition and employment opportunities for 20000 farmers by 2019 by addressing the following:

- ☉ Improving farm productivity through establishment of practical dairy training farms, support on-farm investment, strengthen cooperatives and improves dairy services to farmers
- ☉ Improve milk quality through the introduction and promotion of quality based payment system (QBPS)
- ☉ Improve regulation and investment facilitation
- ☉ Improve household nutrition by; supporting the introduction of school milk in schools and promoting dietary diversity at household level

ARISE and other Local Capacity builders (LCBs) as referred to by SNV under its partnership arrangement have the fourth component of improving household nutrition through promotion of school milk program (SMP)

The project uses schools as the entry point to address nutritional status of households/community nutrition.

Since 2016 August, we started with 10 schools as a pilot and to date we reached 63 schools with a total of 18344 pupils taking 1163 litres of milk per day and different matching grants given participating schools i.e. Sauce pans/boilers, kitchen construction and water purification systems for safe and clean water being given on a co-funding basis.
